# CLASS OF 2018 GRADUATION INSTRUCTIONS

## **GRADUATION CEREMONY ON MAY 31 AT 6:30 P.M.**

## **PRACTICE**

- 1. Practice for graduation will be held at **10:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 31**. <u>Graduates must be on time</u>. Graduates should report directly to the cafeteria. Practice will last until approximately 1:00 p.m.
- 2. **GRADUATES ARE NOT TO MISS PRACTICE.** Those who work should make arrangements with their employers well in advance. Graduates who miss practice will not be allowed to take part in the graduation ceremony unless excused prior to practice by Mr. Luzzo or Dr. Schmitt. Only extenuating circumstances will be taken into consideration. Having to work will not be excused.

#### THE CEREMONY

- 3. Graduation will be held on the athletic field. If the ceremony is held inside because of inclement weather, it will be held in the gym. Graduation tickets are only required if the ceremony is held indoors.
- 4. All fees, obligations, library books due, etc., must be taken care of prior to graduation.
- 5. On Thursday night, graduates are to report to the cafeteria no later than 5:30 p.m. The ceremony will begin at 6:30 p.m. regardless of inside or outside ceremony.
- 6. Dress for graduation night:

Males: Dress shirt and tie, dress pants, socks, and dress shoes

(**no** shorts, tennis shoes, or blue jeans)

Females: Dress, skirt and blouse, or dress slacks and blouse, and dress shoes

(**no** shorts, halters, tennis shoes, or blue jeans)

Caps should be worn flat with the tassel on the right. Girls should bring pins to hold their caps in place.

Graduates not following the above dress requirements will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Diplomas will be available to pick up on June 5.

- 7. Students should not bring cell phones to graduation. Graduates will not be allowed to take their cell phones with them to the ceremony.
- 8. Line-up for the processional will be arranged at the morning practice. Graduates should note their place in line to avoid unnecessary delay in getting to the proper place for the graduation processional.

- 9. Graduates who do not feel they can march in the processional because of a physical issue should see Mr. Luzzo or Dr. Schmitt prior to the May 31 rehearsal. Special arrangements will be made for these students.
- 10. On graduation night, graduates will receive their diploma covers. Diplomas will be available for pick up June 5 in the registrar's office. After June 5, please call the registrar's office at 815.717.3540 to make arrangements to pick up diplomas. Students are required to pick up their diplomas.
- 11. GRADUATES WHO ATTEND THE CEREMONY AND DISRUPT IT IN ANY WAY WILL **NOT** BE ISSUED A DIPLOMA.

### **GRADUATION CAP & GOWN AND COMMENCEMENT TICKET INFORMATION**

- Caps & Gowns distribution, along with Commencement tickets, will be distributed during all lunch hours on May 3. Extra tassels are available for purchase for \$7.00. Questions regarding graduation caps and gowns should be directed to Mrs. Borgo in the Main Office. Obligations must be paid and community service completed prior to picking up commencement tickets and caps & gowns.
- 2. Each graduate will be issued a maximum of five (5) tickets for graduation. The tickets will be used only for the <u>indoor</u> ceremony due to inclement weather. Tickets will be distributed during lunch hours on May 3. If needed, two (2) additional tickets for each graduate can be picked up in the Main Office after practice on May 31.
- 3. There will be enough seating for the outside ceremony so that tickets will not be necessary. Seating will be provided on the athletic field and bleachers.
