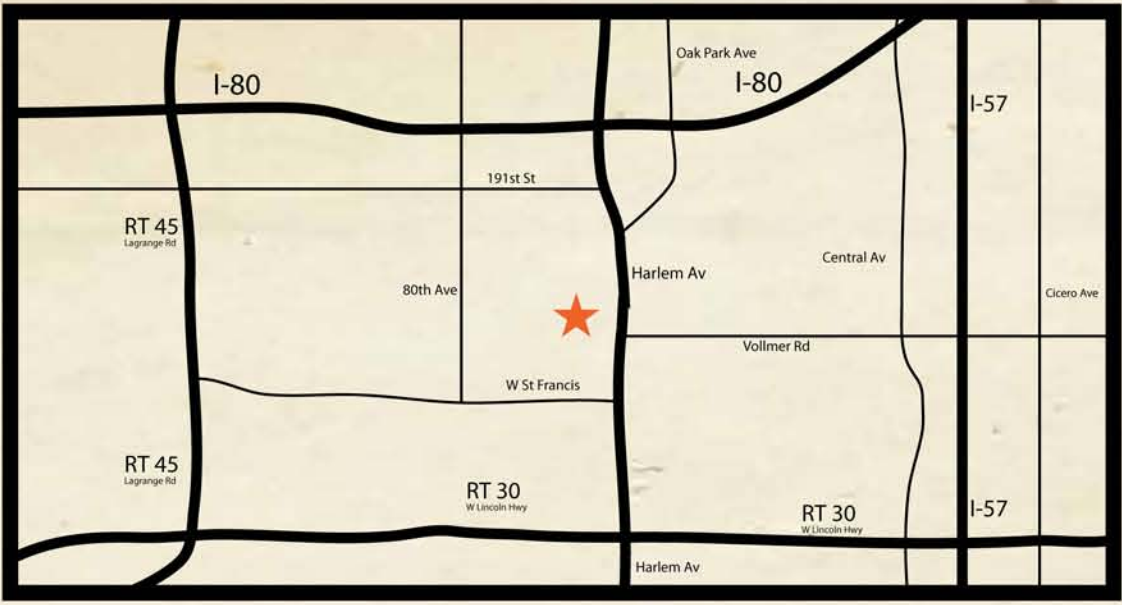

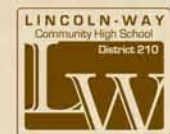

DAVE BENNETT'S "TRIBUTE TO BENNY GOODMAN"

Clarinet virtuoso, Dave Bennett, and his All-Star Septet bring to life the music of "The King of Swing" with incredible technique, expression, and sensitivity.
