

During the 2017 Holiday Season, the Lincoln-Way Foundation Board experienced much success thanks to the generosity of many local businesses and individuals. We are thankful to our donors and proud of our success! We are looking to further grow our fundraising efforts in 2018, and plan to launch a new July fundraiser at CD&ME in Frankfort. We acknowledge and applaud our valuable Partners, donors and volunteers, as they are the key to achieving our academic enhancement mission.

In December 2017, the Board approved a total donation of \$5,670 to be used for the Transition Program, as well as \$100,000 for Lenovo devices and charging carts, as part of an enhanced digital learning environment affecting hundreds of LW students at each school. Since inception, the Foundation has donated \$4.3 million to enhance academic achievements. In 2017 alone we accomplished the following:

Bricks & Cents for Kids 210- Many families continue to support the schools by purchasing bricks at the three locations. These bricks memorialize their special memories and wishes of Lincoln-Way alumni. Lincoln-Way staff, administrators and faculty have graciously supported our mission via a payroll deduction plan. Combined, these events generated over \$13,000 of net donations.

Half Marathon- 2017 was our first year of the LW Half Marathon, netting \$14,000. We had a great turnout in 2017, but we wish to grow the event through increased registration, volunteers and sponsors. In 2017, we raised over \$34,000 net from dinner reservations, monetary gifts, silent and live auctions, as well as a collective Board gift of \$2,800.
